



- The public access bins are located on Naylor Road, across from the water tower. Open 24/7
- We accept, #1 & #2 plastic, cardboard, aluminum cans, steel cans, newspaper, shredded paper, magazines, office paper, pallets, textiles, toner cartridges (new & used) We ask that you separate each recyclable in bags, when you place them in the bins. Thank you.
- Please, NO GLASS, GARBAGE, OLD YARD TOYS, BBQ GRILLS, FURNITURE
- Programs. Sustainability Partnership (CFT) DIY Pallets, crates Free moving boxes & packing paper – Ball gowns – coats – special little dresses – Trees for Troops.
- •During the past 10 years the Recycle Program has provided \$859,185, which has been used for free concerts, special events and facility upgrades, such as the refurbishment of the LETRA water treatment facility. In addition, over the past 5 years, 24K has been provided directly to Units and Other organizations participating in the Sustainability Partnership.




