



### 2024-2025 Flu Drive Starting 1 October

- Active Duty Soldiers & Tricare Dependents 6 months 64 years of age (Those 65 y/o and older are encouraged to seek the higher dose flu vaccine recommended for this age group)
- All Beneficiaries will be screened for eligibility for flu vaccine and offered at regularly scheduled appointments.
- Saturday Flu Drives are 26 OCT & 07 DEC 9:00a.m.-2:00p.m..
- Pediatrics will offer additional appointments of every Friday this flu season for appointments for children 6-17 y/o to get their flu shot.
- Walk in are available at the Immunization Clinic daily from 7:30a.m.-11:00a.m. and 1:00p.m.-3:00p.m. for all Non Active Duty Dependents
   6 months 64 years old.

  TriWest effective 1 January 2025
- TriWest website will be live early November 2024
- Humana contractors will administer your TRICARE benefits in the private sector network until 1 January 2025.



TRICARE Prime Beneficiaries can receive their flu vaccine at no cost at any pharmacy that accepts TRICARE. MEDICARE and TRICARE for Life can receive the flu shot at any pharmacy location that has flu shots.

### Keep in Mind

Military ID is required for children and adults as it serves as your Insurance Card. Call the pharmacy before you go to ensure what age children are able to receive the vaccine. Each location has different rules. Hours and availability of the flu vaccine are subject to change

If you get a flu vaccine off-post, obtain documentation (not a receipt) of the shot.

Documentation should indicate date, vaccine name, manufacturer and lot number. Family members and retirees can ask their clinic nurse to input flu shot into the immunization record.

Active Duty must wait to get the shot through their unit or at RAHC when supplies are available.




