Various projects available include: building blocks, clay, Zoob Builderz, Snap Circuits, beads, scratch art, ball mazes, Play Stix, coloring, painting, K-Nex, Brain Flakes, and much more!

MakerSpace! ADULTS: One Saturday a Month, 1-4pm: A crafting opportunity just for adults (no kids allowed). Each month features a different project; ask at the circulation desk for future activities and to register for upcoming events. January activity is **WOODBURNING**. February activity is quilling. Space is limited.

Displays: Every month we offer displays of featured library media from holiday related material to Heritage Months, Homeschooling Resources to Graphic Audios, Pirates to Animal Heroes, Mythology to Language Learning, and more. We will display a ‘Staff Picks’ selection every month based on staff recommendations.

Crafts-to-Go: We provide some craft kits for families to take home if you can’t make it in to our Storytime on Wednesdays! We put in new stuff weekly, so you can enjoy a fun craft with your kids when you get home.
