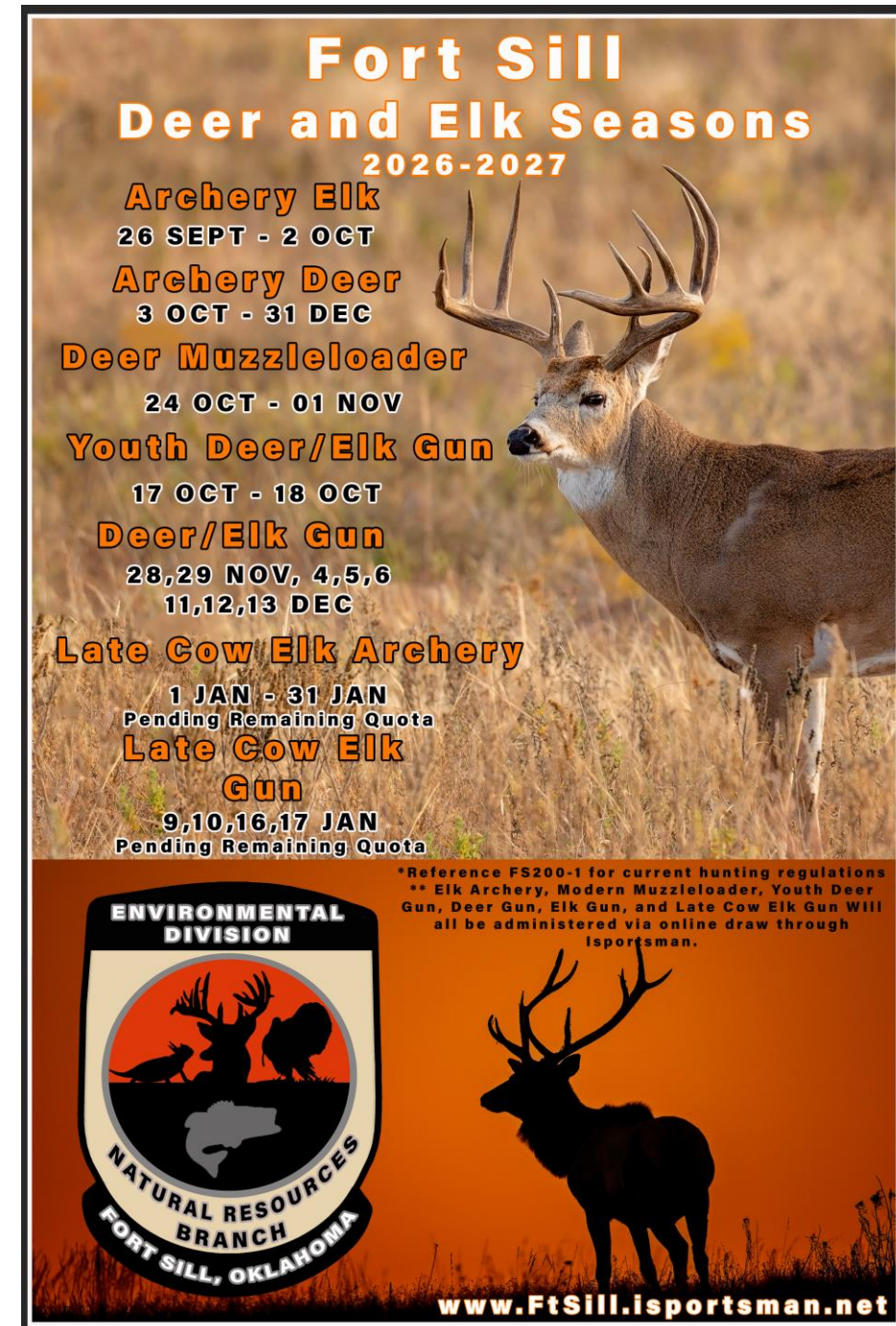

Fort Sill 2026 Hunting Season

Possible Violation

- ❖ Prohibited Hunting Aid/Attractants
 - ❖ Larceny of Private Property
- ❖ Trespassing & Misuse of Master Lock
 - ❖ **Hunting Off Limits Area**
- ❖ Hunting without Proper Licenses

Important Points

- ❖ Review the Summary of Changes to FS Reg 200-1 prior to entering the field
 - ❖ Changes to Training Area Boundaries
 - ❖ Get your Weapons Registered
- ❖ Require Recreationists to Treat Staff Members with Courtesy and Mutual Respect



Emergency Services Updates

Oklahoma SB 54 Took Effect November 1, 2025

- **First-time DUIs** can now be charged as felonies if aggravating factors are present.
- **Aggravated DUI** now includes more than high BAC. Accidents, speeding, or reckless driving can now qualify.
- **Having a child in the vehicle** while impaired can automatically make it a felony.
- **Mandatory jail time** for aggravated DUI convictions, even first-time offenders.
- **Less judicial discretion** - judges have limited ability to suspend or defer sentences.

Protect Our Community

- School is back in session - watch for children

- Stopped for school buses - children may be crossing

Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention Training (ADAPT)

- An evidence-based alcohol and drug education course designed to challenge common beliefs and attitudes that contribute to high-risk substance use.



Ask, Care, Escort Suicide Intervention (ACE-SI) Tier 2 Training

- A Tier-2 Train-the-Trainer course that certifies leaders to teach the annual ACE suicide prevention training. It builds skills to recognize early signs of distress, start honest mental-health conversations, and safely connect teammates to support.



ENGAGE Certification Training

- A course focused on the responsibility to look out for one another. Instead of waiting for a crisis, students learn to step in early when a teammate is struggling or showing high-risk behaviors, and how to use effective intervention skills to safely connect individuals to support.

Use GTCC (IBA) for PCS & TDY Travel

- **Worry-Free Transit:** Activating "PCS Mode" before you depart protects your card from delinquency and ensures seamless, automatic payment processing while you focus on your move.
- **Funded & Mission-Ready:** Using your Government Travel Credit Card (GTCC) is the authorized way to fund official travel, keeping your PCS or TDY trip fully compliant with defense travel regulations.
- **Guaranteed Travel Timelines:** Keeping your GTCC active secures all flights and lodging reservations, ensuring you arrive at your next duty station on schedule.
- **Full Financial Protection:** An active GTCC guarantees direct government payment for your transportation, eliminating personal out-of-pocket expenses and securing your automatic travel entitlements.
- **Strict CBA Restrictions:** The Passenger Travel Office is legally prohibited from absorbing unauthorized travel charges via Centrally Billed Accounts (CBAs) to bypass an inactive IBA. Direct CBA billing is restricted solely to travelers who are officially exempt from carrying an IBA.

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Army Tuition Assistance



- The Army pays up to \$250 per SH and 18 SH per fiscal year
- Soldiers' fiscal year allotment is \$4500
- Soldiers must have an approved education goal prior to requesting TA
- Soldiers MUST complete ArmyIgnitED 101 training and Career Path decide prior to education goal approval
- Soldiers must request TA thru the Army's education portal – ArmyIgnitED

Army Credentialing Assistance

- List of available certifications are on Army COOL website
- Training to prepare for certification exams
- Any books/materials you may need to prepare
- The exam itself
- These funds share the overall \$4500 allotment with TA
- Capped at \$2000 per FY
- Only 1 certification per FY; 3 certifications per 10 yrs of service.

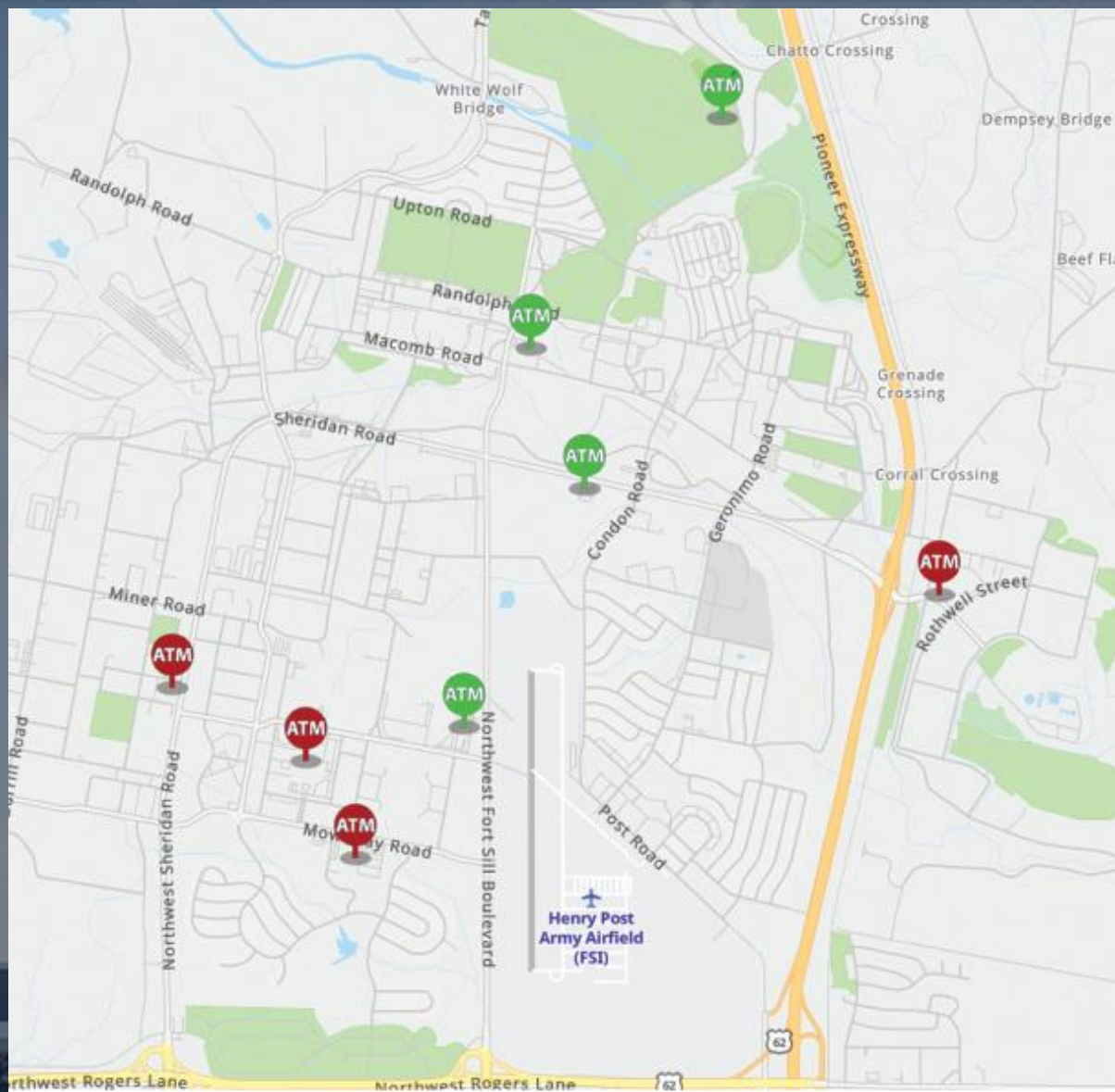

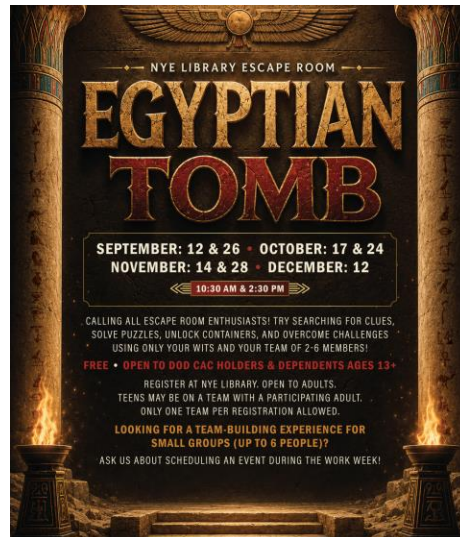
