# **DES Update: Automated Vehicle Barriers**

- Automated Vehicle Barriers (AVBs) are being installed at Key Gate (West) as a part of the ARMY's Security Fielding Plan.
- Key Gate (West) on Sheridan Road will close at 1900 on 16 JAN 25 (Thursday) and remain closed for the duration of the construction project.
- The estimated time for the project to be completed is 6-8 months. We expect to re-open Key Gate (West) in the Fall of 2025.
- Basic Training and AIT Graduations will be hosted on the East side of I-44 vis Key Gate (East).
