## THIRD GRADEREADING SUFFICIENCY

The Oklahoma Core Curriculum Tests (OCCT) measure student progress toward Common Core State Standards. Scores fall into one of four categories: Unsatisfactory, Limited Knowledge, Proficient and Advanced. Oklahoma Law states that third-graders who score Unsatisfactory in reading on the OCCT must be retained (not promoted to fourth grade). Students who are retained must be given intensive instruction in reading to help them catch up.

| Laboratory Science | 3 units including Biology, Chemistry, Physics or other Lab Science course with <br> content and/or rigor equal to or above Biology (including AP science courses) <br> and approved to meet college admission requirements |
| History/Citizenship | 3 units including US History, 1/2 unit US Government, 1/2 unit Oklahoma History <br> + 1 unit approved to meet college admission requirements |
| Foreign Language | 2 units including 2 units of the SAME foreign or non-English Language OR 2 years <br> of Computer Technology) |
| Fine Art/Speech | 1 unit (Music, Art, Drama or Speech) |
| Electives | At least 7 units including personal financial literacy |

## College and Career Readiness Assessments

11th grade students will take the ACT Test at school (at no cost) and a Science content test. A student who has already completed a Science Assessment (Biology or higher) can be exempt from the Science Assessment. The ACT is required.
