ROAD CONDITIONS

Green: Normal driving conditions exist. Amber: Cautionary driving conditions exist. Roads may have slick spots.

Red: Hazardous driving conditions exist. Ice or snow may be sticking to road surfaces. Roads may be covered and with standing or running water. Visibility may be limited. **Black**: Conditions present a life threatening condition or are unpassable due to ice, snow, water or present a visibility problem.

<u>Closed</u>: Roads or a situation has made the road too hazardous for travel.



WINTER WEATHER PREPARATION

Remove, drain and store outdoor hoses Extreme cold-drip faucets throughout home; open kitchen and bathroom cabinet doors Keep the thermostat set to the same temperature during day and night Set to a temperature no lower than 55°F during extended absence Keep roadways clear of vehicles to assist with clearing roads of snow/ice **Ensure Community Office has your updated contact information** Work Order submission available by calling Community Office, Online or in-person **Follow us on Facebook for continued updates**







MEDICAL MARIJUANA

Under new Oklahoma state law, people with a valid medical marijuana license may use medical marijuana in specific instances. However, Federal law overrides state law for all Soldiers as well as all family members living on Fort Sill and any person visiting Fort Sill.

BLUF:

- Use or possession of marijuana on a Federal installation is a violation of federal law, despite the state of Oklahoma amendment to legalize marijuana for medical use.
- Servicemembers are NOT authorized to use marijuana in any capacity. State laws do not override the ban on the use of a schedule 1 controlled substance for Servicemembers.
- Marijuana is prohibited on Fort Sill, and all Federal property.
 - For Family members of Servicemembers who live or work on post as well as those visiting, federal law continues to prohibit the use of marijuana anywhere on post, to include housing areas, parks, and community facilities.

Federal Statute:

- IAW Title 80 section 804 of Oklahoma Statute, Fort Sill Military Reservation was ceded to the United States.
- Tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) is STILL a Schedule I illegal substance (21 USC 812).





REYNOLDS ARMY HEALTH CLINIC

- What is Virtual Medicine? Patient care through any virtual means for the purpose of providing healthcare (also called Virtual Health or Tele Health)
- Examples: Some phone calls, use of secure messaging, Tricare Online, emails with photos, use of online camera consults, a hospital visit with the Doctor connecting from another hospital/clinic

TOWN HALL ISSUES (Submitted prior to 8 Jan 19)





<u>Question</u>: I was taking a Windows 10 class at the Ed Center. Due to bandwidth we were unable to log onto the virtual labs. This class was structured around labs. Not having bandwidth did not allow for the whole experience. This caused the instructor to fall back to a lecture type delivery. I do not learn well from this type delivery. Can the Ed Center plan better or get additional bandwidth to support these classes with labs?

Answer: Commercial internet went down late Monday, 3 Dec 18. A trouble ticket was submitted to the commercial internet provider. Commercial internet came back up Tuesday, 4 Dec 18, but at very limited bandwidth. The outage or low bandwidth issue with commercial internet provider rarely ever occurs, as they have provided excellent customer service to Education Services Division in the past.



<u>Question</u>: On a recent attempt to come onto the installation, one of the gate guards had a personal conversation with a patron for more than one minute about her family and children, acting as if he had no care in the world and owned the gate. This caused cars to pile up behind me while waiting to enter the installation.

<u>Answer</u>: The Security Guards are trained to remain courteous to all customers. When a driver or passenger asks a question, Guards are encouraged to answer occupant questions and to take concern to remain professional at all times. They are to remain cordial at all times to protect the positive reputation of the Fort Sill Access Program.





<u>Question</u>: Why is CYS provided child care (KOS) in the chapels not available on Training Holidays? In the Worship Centers having someone to watch your baby helps patrons focus.

<u>Answer</u>: The current contract does not include this service on Training Holidays. However, it can be updated to include child care in the Worship Centers on Training Holidays. Call Ms. Martin at CYS Outreach Services, 442-4831 to request an update. We hope to hear from you soon.
