Garrison Commander Black Start Brief



What is a Black Start?

- A DoD mandated “exercise” to validate energy resilience for critical missions.
- We are required to disconnect from power for at least 8 hours
- We will respond to power outage and restore power

Key Dates for Black Start?

- 12 Feb: Black Start Rehearsal – No power outages during this event
- 17 Feb: PAO Info Ops Campaign begins across community
- March 2025: Black Start– The Specific DTG is not being released to MAX the TNG

Exercise Day

- N-0 Startex:** Power cut (no notice).
- N+8.5 thru UTC (Endex):** Report damage.

What Should You Do?

- Have a plan when the power goes out.
 - When you are home
 - When you are at work
 - When your children are at school or at after school activities.
