

Garrison Commander Black Start Brief



What is a Black Start?

- -A DoD mandated "exercise" to validate energy resilience for critical missions.
- -We are required to disconnect from power for at least 8 hours
- -We will respond to power outage and restore power

Key Dates for Black Start?

- -12 Feb: Black Start Rehearsal No power outages during this event
- -17 Feb: PAO Info Ops Campaign begins across community
- -March 2025: Black Start- The Specific DTG is not being released to MAX the TNG

Exercise Day

- -N-0 Startex: Power cut (no notice).
- -N+8.5 thru UTC (Endex): Report damage.

What Should You Do?

- -Have a plan when the power goes out.
 - -When you are home
 - -When you are at work
 - -When your children are at school or at after school activities.
