## RAHC UPDATE

- 8 January 2019, RAHC Main Pharmacy implemented two ticket options:

#### **ARMY EMERGENCY RELIEF CAMPAIGN**

2019 Campaign Dates: 1 March through 15 May 19

**2019 Campaign Goal:** 100% Informed and Raise \$130K in donations

Who AER Helps: AER funds support Soldiers on Active Duty, Soldiers Retired from Active Duty, Soldiers Retired Army Reserve and National Guard and their eligible dependents, Soldiers who are receiving retirement benefits and their dependents, Medically Retired Soldiers and their dependents, Surviving Spouses and Children of Soldiers who died while on Active Duty (including those on Title 10 Orders) or in an eligible Retired status.

**2018 AER Assistance**: Fort Sill processed 519 AER cases and provided emergency financial assistance in excess of \$700,000 last year.

### HVAC ISSUE IN GOVERNMENT HOUSING

<u>Issue #1:</u> The HVAC is not working properly, especially in those government homes with a Geothermal system.

<u>Answer:</u> Corvias is following up with every resident who made a comment during the recent Housing Town Hall. The follow up will be completed by close of business on Tuesday, 5 Mar 19.

We have identified that Geothermal systems require more Maintenance than conventional HVAC systems.

We have also identified the 10 homes with the highest number of HVAC service requests and are developing a plan to begin replacement.



## CUSTOMER SERVICE AND PROFESSIONALISM OF HOUSING MAINTENANCE PERSONNEL

<u>Issue #2:</u> The customer service and professionalism of maintenance employees that service government housing is not acceptable.

<u>Answer</u>: Service maintenance technicians will receive bi-monthly customer service training beginning immediately.





## UNEVEN HOME TEMPS AND WATER LEAKS IN GOVERNMENT HOUSING

<u>Issue #3</u>: Window/door seals are leaking, causing drafts in the home and water penetration.

Answer: Corvias is following up with every resident who made a comment during the Housing Town Hall. Follow up will be completed by 5 Mar 19. Once follow-up has occurred, we will identify if there are trends by home type. If issues are found to be large scale, a plan will be developed to address.





Question: The Front Desk Clerk at the Radiology Clinic was very rude. She told the ringing phone to "shut up, you're bothering me". When the staff member sitting next to her asked if the people in back knew they had 3 people waiting, the Front Desk Clerk said, "don't know, don't care". Finally, she negatively talked about a Reynolds Clinic to a patient (Nuclear Medicine) saying they don't do their jobs and never answer the phone. This was completely unprofessional, all of her behavior.
