- **Who requires Passports/VISAS?**

Authorization Document/Orders, Application, Photo, ID Card, Evidence of Citizenship.

- **When should you start your application process?**

We advise that you start the application process at six months prior to report date.

The Impacts of Summer Surge

Summer Surge is not just a delay—it is a capacity constraint. Early engagement with the Transportation Office and Passport Agent is the primary factor in a successful movement.

- **Passports/Visas**

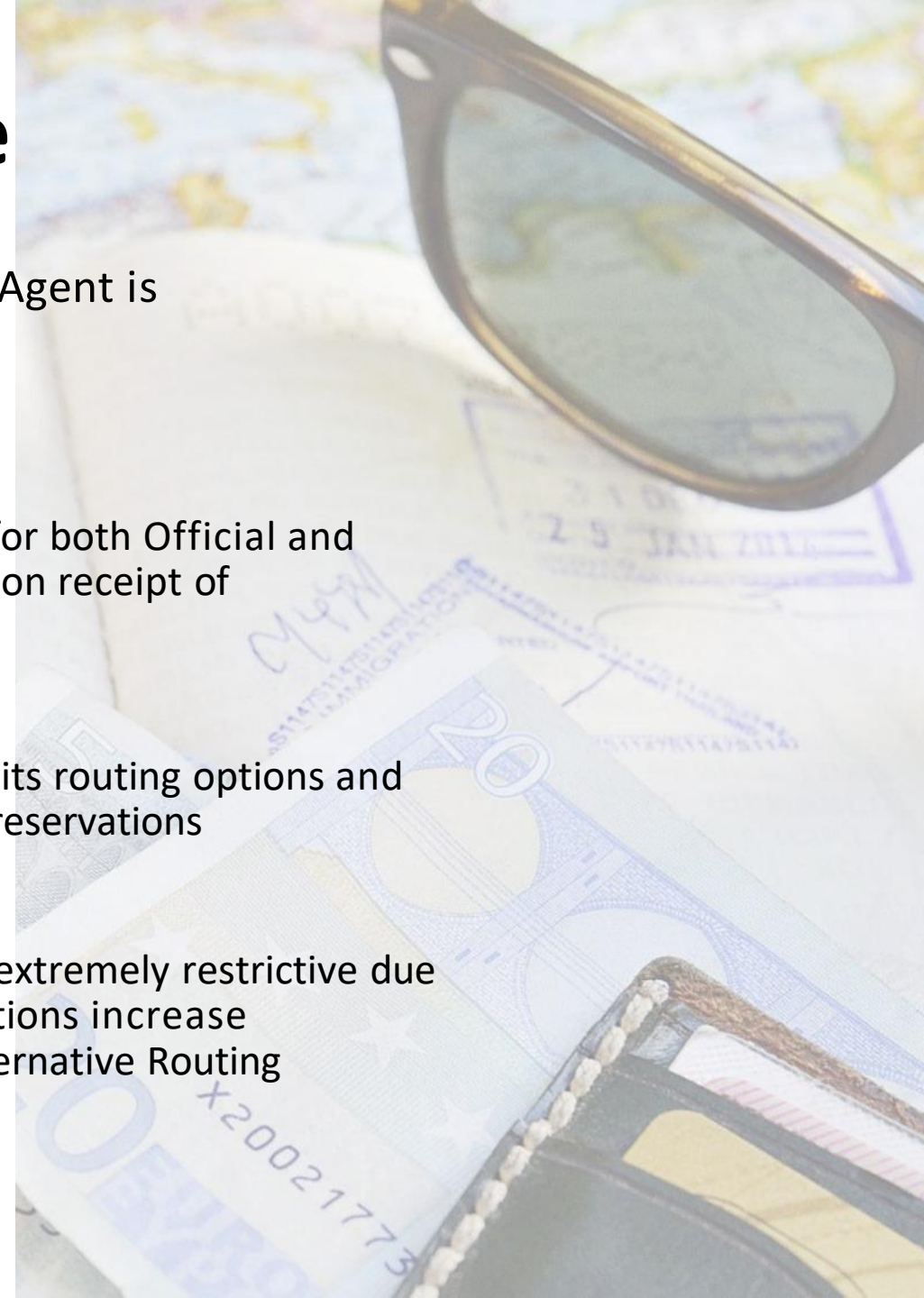
Increased volume leads to extended turnaround times for both Official and Tourist Passports. Submit applications immediately upon receipt of notification/orders.

- **PCS Routing**

High demand for transoceanic and domestic flights limits routing options and seat availability. See us in Passenger Travel to confirm reservations

- **Pet Movement Restrictions**

Commercial airline policies during summer months are extremely restrictive due to temperature safety regulations. Temperature prohibitions increase constraints. Heat Stress Bans – Space Limitations – Alternative Routing

- **Why?**
 - **High Costs:** Requires over \$250,000 in repairs.
 - **Low Attendance:** Averaged fewer than six visitors per hour in 2025.
 - **Fiscal Responsibility:** Continuing to operate the pool is not a sustainable use of resources.
 - **Where to Swim:** Enjoy other on-post facilities, including LETRA, Southern Plains, Old Cavalry Post, and Rinehart Fitness Center, plus splash pads across the post.
