# **Oklahoma Weather Prediction? Crazy. That's it.**

- Weather for Fort Sill for the next 30 days shows no appreciable precipitation with high temperatures ranging from the low 40s to the low 60s
- Great news, right?!....don't fool yourself. The Hawk is out there. And he's coming. He won't give us much warning, but you can take it to the bank that he's coming.
- Historically in SW Oklahoma we have our cold weather from mid-January until mid-March. So it's coming!

# **A winter storm is coming! What do you do?!**

- Stock up on supplies! Do the Oklahoma thing and buy four gallons of milk and six loaves of bread.
- Open all undercabinet doors in bathrooms, laundry rooms...wherever you have a water line coming into your home.
- Let your faucets drip in areas of your house that are warm. If a bathroom is far away from the best heat...let it go into a small steady stream of water! Water is cheaper than the cleanup from a busted pipe.
- Make sure your outside faucets are covered/insulated.
- Turn your heat up!
- Insulate pipes that need it! Pool noodles are great insulators.

# **One Single Window.**

- Fort Sill has the distinction of having the single costliest window in the history of Oklahoma.
- Those windows cost us \$659 each when installed by the contractor.
- The costliest window in Oklahoma was left open during subzero temperatures a few days after the Soldiers had departed on Christmas exodus in 2022. But one group of Soldiers left without closing the window. And nobody in leadership caught it right away.
- At least four different times the unit was told about the open window BEFORE it froze up...and still no action was taken.

## Oklahoma DUI Law Updates

- New DUI-related laws went into effect on Nov 1st.
- It modifies several provisions related to DUI and DUI-D
- One significant modification is the addition to T47 O.S. § 11-902 of a series of circumstances that will elevate a DUI violation to a felony.

## Holiday Fire Prevention

- Do not daisy chain surge protectors or extension cords.
- Only use approved space heaters on Fort Sill (FS 420-90)
- Plug space heaters directly into a wall outlet, give them at least 3 feet of space, and remember to turn them off.
- Keep your natural Christmas trees watered daily.
- Burn bans and red flag warnings still occur during the winter months.
- Do not fry your turkey inside or in the garage.
- Call 911 for ANY fires.
