13th Annual Fort Sill Pro Am Tournament **July 16, 2022 Rules**

- 1. Amateurs complete 3 games of 9 Pin No Tap Bowling on the same pair of lanes assigned by tournament manager. Amateurs will score a complimentary strike anytime they knock down 9 or more in a frame.
- 2. Entering averages will be the 2021-22 yearbook average for all divisions. If no 2021-22 yearbook average, a 2021 sanctioned Fall or Summer League average with a minimum of 21 games may be used. If still no average, a bowler 12 years to collegiate will use a 215 base average and any over 50 and adult will be scratch.

Pro Am Director has the right to re-rate bowlers upon entry.

- 3. Tournament handicap will be based on 90% of 225.
- 4. All averages must be verified prior to entering tournament. Bowlers are responsible for his/her verification of average. Failure to use proper average or make corrections prior to bowling will result in disqualification if average on entry is lower than actual average. Please check in at least 30 minutes prior to squad start time.
- 5. Pro's will move every game giving the amateurs the chance to bowl with 3 different professional's.
- 6. The 10 pin rule will NOT apply. The action of the tournament manager shall be final. Any rule not covered shall be governed by USBC rules.
