BREAST IMAGING CENTER

- Routine mammogram screening
- Diagnostic mammography w/dedicated breast **ULTRASOUND**
- Bone density exams

Monday 0720-1500/Tuesday-Friday 0720-1700

Call 580-558-2780 to schedule self-referred screening mammograms. Diagnostic mammograms and bone density exams need PCM referrals

Screening mammography should be performed annually on all women starting at age 40. Every patient seen in our facility is screened for high risk status. Those who are considered high risk can be enrolled in the breast MRI screening program



HIRING EVENT & EDUCATION FAIR

WARRIOR ADVENTURE QUEST

- Warrior Adventure Quest (WAQ) is an Army RESET training tool
- It is designed to introduce Soldiers to high adventure activities as an alternative to aberrant behaviors often associated with accidents
- This tool presents coping outlets to help Soldiers deal with high risk behaviors while providing an opportunity for team building





WARRIOR ADVENTURE QUEST



The WAQ program is provided at ZERO cost to the unit

Open to all units provided they complete all levels of training

Unit selects one of the high adrenaline alternative activities, scheduled with FMWR. These include:

Paintball, Whitewater Rafting, Go Karts, Escape Lawton, Rock Climbing, Archery Tag, Axe Throwing, Backpacking, Ropes Course, and Kayaking.

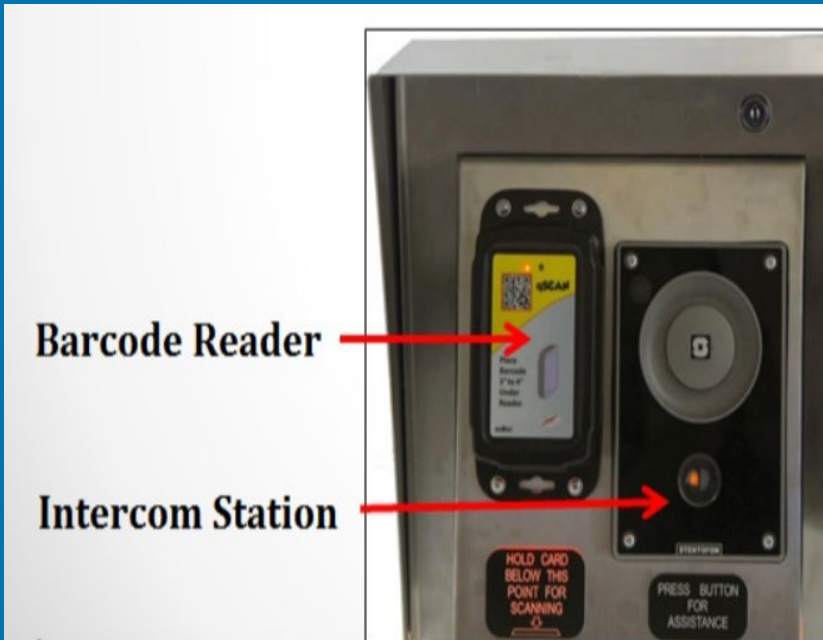


52d STREET GATE OPENING

AIE-3 KIOSK IMPLEMENTATION



Overview:

- 90 day test of the AIE-3 Kiosk & drop-arms at Bentley Gate began 17 February. Testing of the AIE-3 Kiosk will be performed between the hours of 0500 and 2200 a day, 7 days a week.
- Guards/BMM will provide oversight and assistance to drivers in each lane
- Traffic slow-downs are expected for the first 30 days as commuters become familiar with the kiosks
