Separating Service Members cannot be off-boarded with active flags.

- All active flags must have an end date prior to actual separation date
- (Note: separation date is different from final out date)

Soldiers are required to bring two copies of Orders and approved Absence Request.

Soldiers can attend out-processing briefing 10 working days prior to the start of their leave.





PCS Orders

The Integrated Personnel and Pay System – Army (IPPS-A) has changed our processes for PCS orders. There is less paperwork and Soldiers get direct email notice once orders are complete. If Soldier has questions about the process, please contact your S-1.

- Reassignments is not notified of changes made within IPPS-A (i.e. Member elections completed, report date changes, etc.), Soldiers should notify their S-1 and their S-1 should notify Reassignments of these changes.
- PCS orders are processed in order of report date once all actions have been completed. If Soldier has special circumstances (i.e. early report, TDY en-route, family move not to PCS location, etc.), Soldiers should notify their S-1 and their S-1 should notify Reassignments of these changes.
- Enterprise-Exceptional Family Member Program (E-EFMP) System – This system is used for the Command Sponsorship Program (CSP) for OCONUS screening of dependents. Orders cannot be completed until CSP is approved. The process can take up to 30+ days once gaining location has received the packet in E-EFMP.

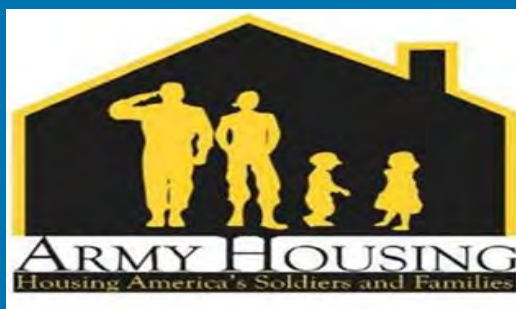

Move-out notification



30 day notice required

- Improper Notice Fee applies for notice **less than 30 days** unless short orders provided.
- Orders not required for notice
 - Orders required prior to moving out
- Termination Fee
 - Applies for breaking lease prior to 12-month term without orders
 - Equals one month rent





Turn Over Standards

- Clean conditions at move-out
- Remove all personal belongings including trash & pet waste.
- Vacuum carpet and remove of spots/stains
- Return wall color to same as move-in or white primer
- Pay all balances owed
- Return all keys, garage remotes, and key fobs
- Attend Move out briefing
- Schedule Pre-Inspection
- Refer to the Resident Responsibility Guide (RRG) or contact any of the community centers for specific questions regarding cleaning items and home conditions in order to have an easy turn over process

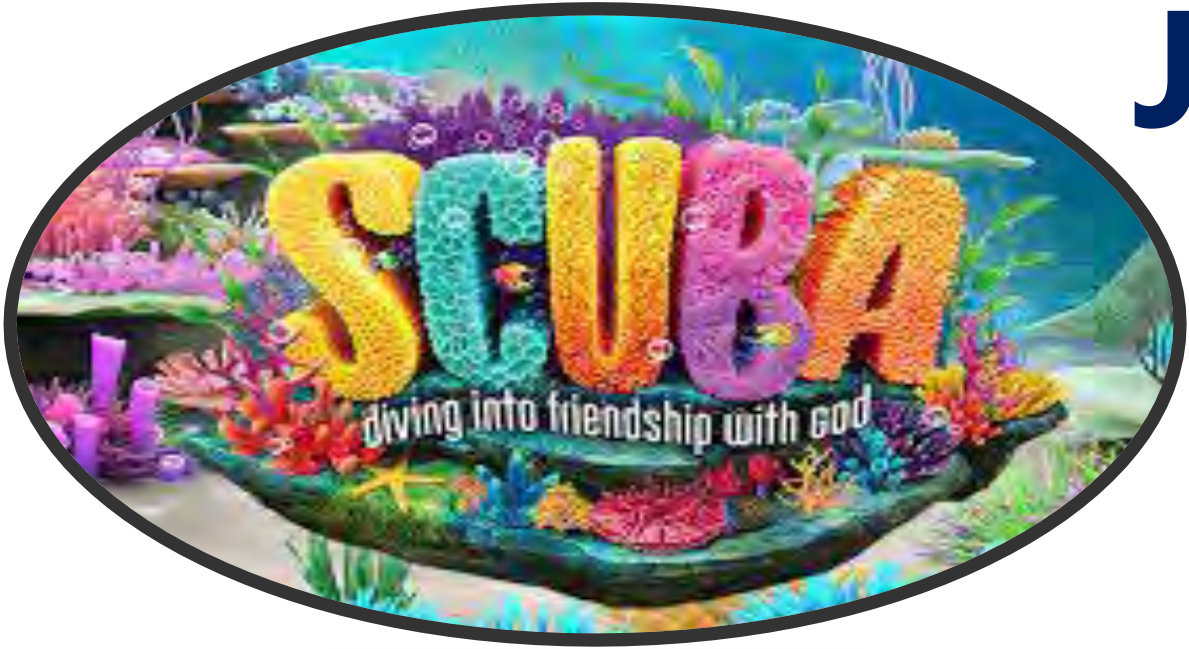

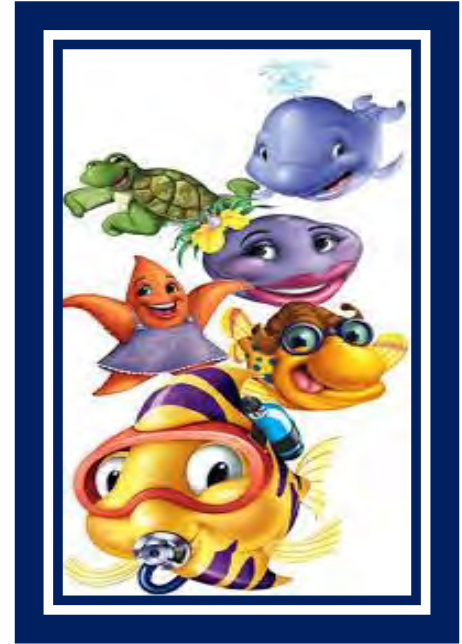
