Tutor.com for U.S. Military Families Frequently Asked Questions



What is Tutor.com for U.S. Militaryamilies?

Tutor.com for U.S. Military Families (Tutor.com/military), funded by the U.S. Department of Defense (DoD) and Coast Guard Mutual Assistance (CMGA), is a program that allows eligible students in grades kindergarten through college to connect to a live tutor online at any time (24/7/361) for one-to-one help with homework, studying, test prep and more, at no cost.

Who is eligible to use Tutor.com/military?

To support DoD-affiliated personnel and their families who are being impacted by COVID-19 disruptions, DoD Military Community and Family Policy (MC&FP) leadership temporarily expanded eligibility for Tutor.com/ military. As of April 2020, all DoD service members, civilian personnel and all dependent family members are eligible. DoD military children in grades K-12, Coast Guard families and DoDEA students who were eligible to use Tutor.com/military prior to April 2020 will continue to access the program as usual.

Who are the tutors?

Every Tutor.com tutor is a carefully screened expert. Our team of more than 3,000 tutors includes certified teachers, college professors and other professionals. We actively recruit military spouses, and many of our tutors are affiliated with the U.S. military, such as retirees and Veterans.

How does Tutor.com work?

Tutor.com has more than 3,000 background-checked tutors to provide expert, on-demand academic support 24/7. Eligible students worldwide can access the service from any internet-enabled device for real-time help in more than 100 subjects, plus standardized test prep and more. Students and tutors work one-to-one in a secure online classroom that uses text or voice chat, interactive whiteboard, graphing calculator, file sharing, text editor and more.
