- PERSONAL PROPERTY SHIPPING PROCESS
- As soon as you get orders, go to the Transportation office (Personal Property, BLD 4700)
- Must have a complete set of ORDERS and ALL Amendments
- If OCONUS, ensure family members have updated EFMP, if applicable, and are listed on the orders by NAME AND DOB
- If shipping firearms, motorcycle, ATV or boat have registrations and info on firearms (SN and manufacturer)
- Make sure that you separate all property you want to move yourself so that movers do not pack it
- It is important the movers list your PRO GEAR so that it is not counted against your allowance
- Know your weight entitlement for your rank/grade

• Do it yourself PPM(DITY)

- You must have POV Registrations for all vehicles/trailers (If title or registration is not in YOUR name, have a letter of authorization with you signed by the owner, stating it is ok to use that vehicle/trailer from here to there, or a rental agreement.)
- Authorized 90 days of storage to be reimbursed when you set up the PPM(DITY) move.
- Save all gas, tolls, boxes, packaging material-they count as non-taxable expenses on the PPM(DITY) move.
- DO NOT start anything without HARD COPY ORDERS in hand, otherwise you will not be able to be reimbursed for the PPM(DITY).
- Make sure you have pick up and drop off contracts and empty and full weight tickets.
- Make sure you look up the company before hiring them if doing PPM(DITY) to make sure you do not get taken advantage of during this stressful time

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Total Army Sponsorship Program (TASP)

TASP is a Commander's Program and an essential part of helping Soldiers, Civilians, and Families adjust to their new duty station.

Purpose: Greet incoming Soldiers and their Family members in accordance with unit policy and assist during initial in-processing, as needed. After initial in-processing, sponsors will provide assistance on a decreasing level based on the Soldier's ability to function independently. The sponsor will encourage and coach new arrivals to function independently in the community as soon as possible.

Sponsor Selection - To the greatest extent possible, sponsors will be leaders and are:

- Equal in grade or higher than the incoming or departing Soldier
- Same gender, marital status, and military career field or occupational series as the inbound Soldier.
- Familiar with the unit, activity, and community
- Only individuals who represent the gaining unit or activity in a positive manner will be selected as sponsors

DA Form 5434 – Sponsorship Program Counseling and Information Sheet is a document used for transmitting sponsorship requirements to gaining commands. The form is filed by departing Soldiers following the initial reassignment interview and acceptance notification, respectively.

Who require a Sponsor: E1-E-6, O1-O3, W1-CW2

Army Goal – Sponsors assigned 120 days from report date (PP Soldiers); 5 days Initial Military Training Soldiers.

Welcome Letters - Once a sponsor has been appointed, a welcome letter will be immediately available to the incoming Soldier via TASP Module in the Army Career Tracker (ACT). The sponsor is encouraged to send a more personalized unit welcome letter with detailed information about the unit/installation at a later date.

- Documents need to be submitted by email in order to be cleared through ISMs (orders, Absence Request.)
- Dislocation Allowance (DLA) and travel advances (if authorized) are completed using SmartVoucher.
 - Advances may be submitted 30 days before PCS.
 - Orders with any amendments and absence requests must be submitted for advances.
- TLE (if authorized)
 - CONUS to CONUS authorized up to 14 days, can be used at losing or gaining station.
 - CONUS to OCONUS authorized up to 7 days, must be used at the CONUS station.
 - Must have zero balance close-out lodging receipt.
- HR Professionals must depart Soldiers in IPPS-A.

- PCS In-Processing Briefings are conducted M-W-T-F at 1245 in Rm G29 of Bldg 4700.
- Travel vouchers will be completed using SmartVoucher.
- Documents required for in-processing:
 - Orders and any amendments.
 - Absence requests.
 - DD1610 (if TDY enroute.)
 - Lodging receipts for TLE.
 - Airfare receipts.
 - Receipts for any expense over \$75.00.
- HR Professionals must arrive Soldiers in IPPS-A and adjust absences/travel days.
- Ensure Soldiers in-process the finance office at new duty station to avoid interruptions in pay!!!!

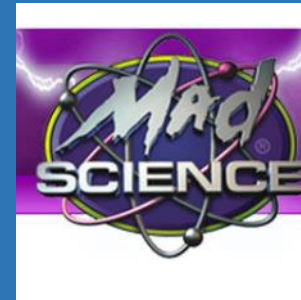
