PCS Season Move-in Prep

Apply online at **Sill.CorviasPM.com** ** bring your boxes to the recycle center

Documents needed to accept a home:

- ✓ Orders to Fort Sill
- ✓ DD-1172 (DEERS)
- ✓ LES-End of month prior to move-in showing service member is receiving the "With Dependent BAH rate".

Pets need:

- ✓ Photos & vaccination records
- ✓ Must register pet with Fort Sill Vet within 10 days of move-in
- ✓ Read & sign lease a minimum of 5 business days before move-in
- ✓ Use payment portal to pay pro-rated rent and pet deposits
- ✓ *Note* Move-in dates are tentative and may change

Emergency Services Updates

- New hours for the Visitor Welcome Center (VWC)
Open 7 days a week 0700-1700
- Visitors that do not have a DOD ID will need a pass to access Fort Sill
 - Real ID holders can request a pass in person or online
 - If a visitor does not have a REAL ID, they must go in person to the VWC and present two forms of acceptable, and valid, identification
- Key Gate West is projected to open back up in fall 2025
