# Visitor Passes

Fort Sill Visitor Welcome Center (VWC) hours: **0700 - 1700**

- Fort Sill does not participate in the Trusted Traveler Program.
  - All visitors must undergo vetting and receive an official visitor pass.
- Request a pass in person at the VWC or online at least 24 hours in advance.
- Visitors must have a REAL ID or two valid forms of identification.
  - contact the VWC for what is acceptable
- Who all needs a pass?
  - All adults (18+) who do not possess a DoD-approved identification card (CAC, Retiree ID, Dependent ID).
  - Any vehicle driver aged 16 or 17.
- If the VWC is closed, passes can be obtained at Bentley Gate.

# Reynolds Army Health Clinic

## • Tick Awareness and prevention



- Grasp the tick at the surface of the skin using fine-tipped tweezers
- Pull tick straight up and out
  - Don't twist or jerk the tick this can cause the mouth parts to break off and stay in the skin
- Clean the bite and hands
  - rubbing alcohol, an iodine scrub, or soap and water
- **Do not** put hot matches, nail polish, or petroleum jelly on the tick
- Reduce the chances of disease by removing ticks quickly (within 24 hours)

## • Tick removal and testing

- Beneficiaries can report to the UCC for tick removal and testing.
- Removed tick will be sent to the MilTICK program, patients will be notified if a tick-borne disease is found.

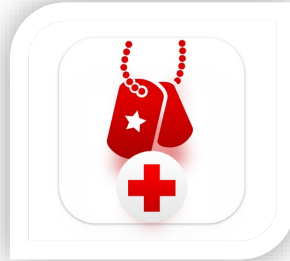

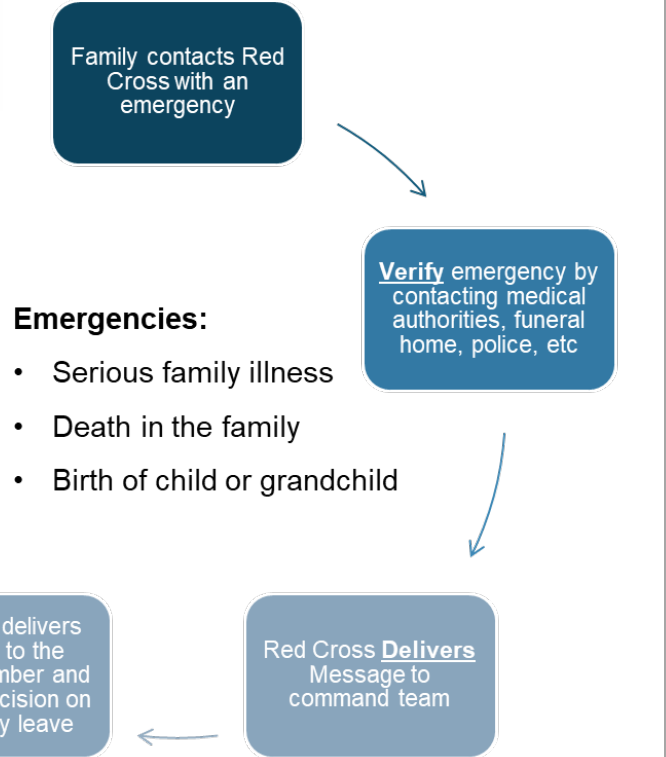
