

WARRIOR ADVENTURE QUEST

Purpose: To facilitate the connection between the challenges of participation in a high adventure activity and the challenges of Soldier transition after deployment, the recommendation of the IPT was to combine high adrenaline outdoor recreation (ODR) activities with the Army Medical Department (AMEDD) psychological resiliency building program. Their Leader-led after action debriefing (L-LAAD) techniques were fashioned to create such a connection and assist Soldiers in realizing a "new normal".

- Any Army Unit is eligible for WAQ once per every 12 months, regardless of deployment status.
- Army National Guard and Reserve are considered Army Units and therefore eligible, while under Title 10 status.



Documents needed to accept a home:

- ✓ Orders to Fort Sill
- ✓ DD-1172 (DEERS)
- ✓ LES-End of month prior to move-in
- ✓ Absence form-This replaces the DA31
- ✓ Pets need:
 - Photos & vaccination records
 - Must register pet with Fort Sill Vet within10 days of move-in

Read & sign lease a minimum of 5 days before move-in Use payment portal to pay pro-rated rent and pet fees







Move-out Procedures

30-day notice required

Orders not required for notice but are required for move-out

Termination Fee/Late Notice Fee

Clean condition at move-out:

- ✓ Remove all personal belongings including trash & pet waste.
- ✓ Vacuum carpet & remove spots/stains
- ✓ Return wall color to same as move-in or white primer
- ✓ Pay all balances owed
- ✓ Return all keys, garage remotes, and key fobs




