# What is required for enrollment?

- 1. Birth Certificate
- Pre-K 4 years old on/before 1 SEPT 2. Immunization Record
  - 3. Social Security Number (student)
  - 4. Proof of Parent/Custodian address (must live on post to attend Freedom Elementary.)
  - 5. Custody or guardian papers filed through the court. (if applicable)

## How do I enroll for school?

Contact the school district directly to learn about their enrollment process or go to the school's website for information. The School Liaison Officer (SLO) is always available to answer any questions regarding enrollment by calling 580-442-2130.

## SCHOOL CHOICE OPTIONS:

- Public School Choice: Oklahoma's public school choice options include intra-district and inter-district transfers which are considered on a space-available basis. To guarantee placement in desired school district, families should secure housing in that district or transportation area.
- **Private Schools:** Private schools registered with the State Department of Education are listed at http://sde.ok.gov/sde/private-school-services
- Home Schools: Homeschools are not regulated and Oklahoma law does not require parents to register with or seek approval from state or local officials. Valuable resources can be found at http://ok.gov/sde/home-school or Oklahoma Homeschooling Information at http://www.oklahomahomeschool.com/
