Non-Subsistence-in-Kind (SIK) personnel and family are authorized to eat the Thanksgiving meal at rate of \$9.55 each.

Immediate Family Member of E1-E4, Soldiers on Field Duty or Essential Unit Messing, and Soldiers on post temporarily not receiving per diem pay \$7.10 per person.

The Thanksgiving meal is: Roast Turkey w/gravy, Herb-crusted Salmon, Strip Loin Steak or Prime Rib w/Au Jus, Baked or Spiral Ham, Shrimp Cocktail, Mashed Potatoes, Lentils & Rice, Macaroni & Cheese, and a variety of hot vegetables and soups, drinks and desserts.
