FISHING LICENSE REQUIRED

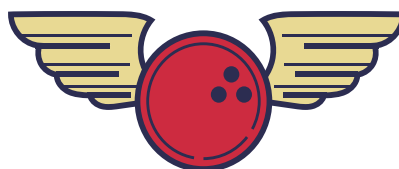

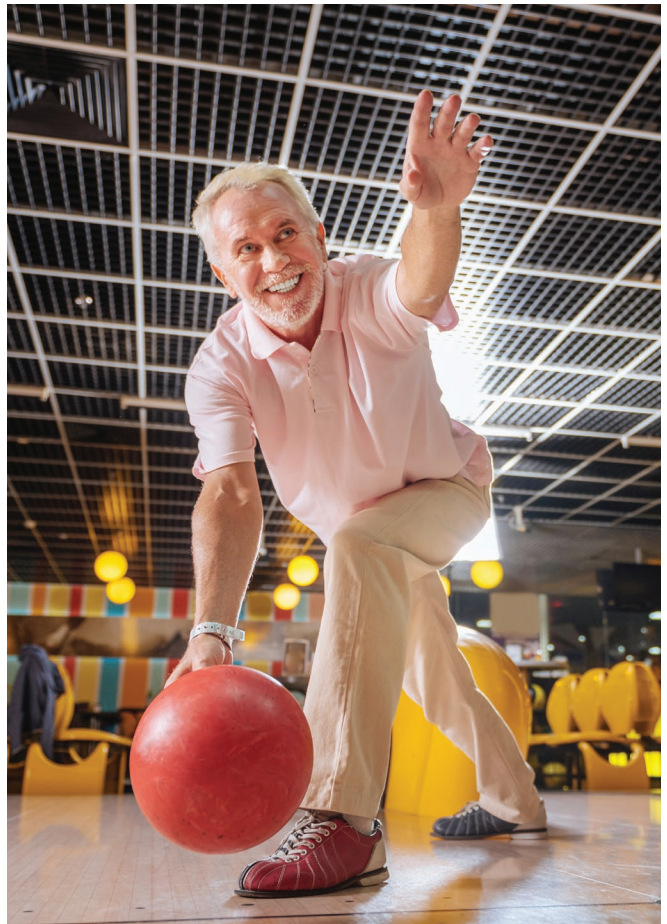
