## Winter Fire Safety

**Cold weather does NOT mean low fire risk**

- Dry grass + Oklahoma winds = **fire danger**
- Check local burn conditions and restrictions
- Avoid burning on windy days
- **Never** leave fires unattended
- Give space heaters at least **3 feet of space** on all sides
- Plug space heaters **directly** into the wall
- **Never** start or warm up your vehicle in a closed garage. Carbon monoxide can build up quickly and enter your home through doors and vents.

# RETIREMENT SERVICES

**Pre-Retirement Briefings:** Retirement Services Office hold Pre-Retirement briefings on the first Tuesday of every month, unless that date falls on a Federal Holiday. When that occurs, the briefing is moved to the following Tuesday. Increasing attendance among Service Members and their spouses remains essential so they receive accurate, reliable information rather than depending on unofficial guidance from peers or informal sources.

**Survivor Benefit Plan (SBP) Briefing:** All retiring Service Members must complete their SBP packet through the Retirement Service Office. This requirement support serves two critical objectives and ensure the process is handle accurately and in accordance with police.

- Establishment of Retirement Account:** Completing this task is critical for establishing your retirement account and must be finalized no later than 90 days before your retirement date. The only exception to this requirement is for Service Members undergoing a medical retirement.
  
- Completion of SBP Plan:** If your SBP plan is not finalized prior to retirement, you will be automatically enrolled and obligated to pay premiums for a minimum of 24 months. Please be aware that these premiums are non-refundable, as required by Federal law.

# ID CARDS – DEERS UPDATE

**Missing Identity Documents:** Over the coming months, the Defense Manpower Data Center (DMDC) will initiate a phased email notification process impacting approximately 400,000 holders of Common Access Cards (CAC) and Next Generation (NextGen) cards who currently lack the necessary identity documents in their records.

**Action Required:**

Affected individuals are instructed to visit their nearest ID Cards Office to complete the document upload process. It is imperative that this process is finalized within 180 days to prevent termination of CAC/NextGen privileges.

**Documents to Bring:**

Please bring original documents or certified true copies of any missing identity documentation. The upload process is designed to take only a few minutes per individual.

**Recommendation:**

To minimize wait times, we highly recommend scheduling an appointment in advance. Please note that Wednesday afternoons have been designated specifically for addressing these types of issues, and services will be provided on a first-come, first-served basis.
