ID CARD SECTION AT FORT SILL

Question: I called the ID card section and was told I had to make an appointment beginning 4 Jan 21. I am retired, live out of area, and drive some distance to get there (weather permitting). Why is an appointment now required? Will walk ins on a space available basis not be seen any more?





NYE LIBRARY ADULT BOOK CLUB

Question: The Adult Book Club at Nye Library was cancelled for January 2021. The staff could not tell me why. The January book is now moved to February, and the February book is now moved to March, etc. Who cancelled it, and why?



REYNOLDS ARMY HEALTH CLINIC

Question: Will civilian employees at Fort Sill who are direct service providers and have daily contact with the general public on Fort Sill receive a COVID vaccine on Fort Sill (ex: travel clerks, in/out processing personnel, child care providers, human resource assistants, etc.)?



WELCOME CENTER ENTRANCE

Comment: I saw a sign in B4700 saying all persons have to enter through the north door (main entrance) as of 6 Jan 21. This creates hardship for both employees and patrons with physical issues that must walk further to get to the area they need. It also exposes patrons to possibly COVID contaminated areas as they walk through the building vs a more direct route. What is the reason for this decision?
